



Nevada State Princess FAQ Sheet

What does being a Nevada State Princess entail to?

When your child registers to be a Nevada State Princess, she is enrolled in the 2017 Princess Camp that is held during Miss Nevada Week. During the months before the state pageant, your child either chooses a mentor (a Nevada local titleholder) or has one assigned to her. With that, your child will attend the three day princess camp led by a fabulous team of Princess volunteers while playing fun games, spending time with their mentors, participating in crafts and activities, and learning a dance that will be performed during the Miss Nevada's Outstanding Teen and Miss Nevada Pageants.

How long will my child hold her title as a Nevada State Princess?

Your child will hold their title from the day they are crowned at the 2017 Princess pageant, until the 2018 Princess Pageant.

Can my child be a princess more than once?

Of course! That is highly encouraged. The more time they spend with their mentors and the program, the more prepared they are when it's their turn to compete for a title!

What is the Nevada State Princess Pageant?

Our Princess Pageant is NOT a competition. We hold a friendly and fun princess crowning ceremony where your child is given a crown and sash by their mentors. They have the opportunity to experience what it is like to be crowned like their titleholders. Parents are welcome. It is a wonderful production!

How old does my child need to be to be in the program?

As of June 27 2016, NO YOUNGER THAN 5, NO OLDER THAN 12.

Do I need to purchase tickets to watch my child perform at the Miss Nevada pageants?

YES. If you do not have a ticket, you will not be allowed to enter the theater or be able to watch your child perform. Tickets will be sold online months before the pageant, and will be available at the box office.

Do I need to purchase an additional ticket for my child? Or will she be given one?

You will need to purchase a ticket for your child (so you can sit together). A ticket will NOT be provided for your child.

When is the late fee assessed?

May 1, 2017, you will be charged \$50 more for late registration.

Does my child have any other duties after the pageant?

No, but it is encouraged that they attend appearances and events with their mentors while wearing their crowns and sashes!

What does my child receive during the Princess Camp?

Crown, sash, a photo with their mentor, crafts, a pizza party, princess breakfast with their mentor, memories, and so much more (once the schedule is out, you will know everything the princess camp entails to)
